About the National Lottery Community Fund

- We're the largest single source of funding for community activities in the UK.
- National Lottery players contribute around £30 million to good causes every week.
- The National Lottery Community Fund distributes around £600m a year to communities across the UK
- Have 2 "open" programmes available in England





Music in hospitals and care

National Lottery Awards for All

- Grants from £300 up to £20,000 for up to two years
- Can only hold one grant at a time and for a maximum of £20,000 within a 12-month period
- Prioritises groups with smaller incomes
- Applications must show meaningful community involvement in planning and delivery of work
- Organisations cannot apply to other programmes for the same project over the same period if awaiting decision
- Applications are on-line, using a response to 3 questions
- Apply at any time check website for current decision times



Reaching Communities

Offers a larger amount of funding (over £20,001) for projects that last up to five years. We're looking for projects that work with their community – whether that's a community living in the same area, or people with similar interests or life experiences.



Reaching Communities Programme

- England divided into 6 regions
- Each region has a local team
- Regions are responsible for delivering our corporate objectives but have a degree of flexibility to meet locally identified priorities
- Can make awards of between 1 and 5 years
- Can make decisions of up to £500k
- Can recommend funding over £500k
- Deliver innovative collaborative approaches for place based action
- Encourage strategic partnerships with key stakeholders
- Award over £330m annually

Though our funding is available to all communities, we'll take an equity-based approach.

This means across all our work with communities and our four missions, we'll invest most in places, people and communities who experience poverty, disadvantage and discrimination.
